Student Policy Manual and One to One Handbook

The 2020-2021 Student Policy Manual was adopted and approved by the St. James Parish School Board Tuesday, July 28th. Beginning this school year, all Pre-K through 12th grade students attending St. James Parish Schools will have the opportunity to take iPads home for continuous learning needs. iPads will be available for use to Pre-K through 12th grade students at school once technology fees are collected and consents are completed. Students in grades 7th through 12th will be able to bring devices home once all fees are collected and consents are completed. Students in Pre-K through 6th grade will receive devices for home use if all fees have been collected and consents completed after beginning of the year assessments are completed. Parents will be notified by the school when devices will be available for home use.

The Student Policy Manual is available [HERE](#) and on the district's website. Parents are encouraged to use the electronic signature option to provide their consents to the Student Policy. It is important that parents and students read the Student Policy Manual and One to One Handbook before signing consents. Parents and students will need to sign where appropriate. Click [HERE](#) for the link to provide **electronic consents**. One form per child must be submitted. Forms can be submitted on any form of mobile devices. Parents are also encouraged to pay technology fees online using MySchoolBucks. If MySchoolBucks is not the preferred method for paying for the technology fee, parents can pay at the school using accepted payment methods (cash, check, money order). The elementary school stores will be open for payments today.

SJP WiFi/Hotspot Information

The district purchased hotspots based on the results provided from the Internet Availability and Contact Survey in April. Each hotspot is programmed to provide internet service to ONLY SJPS iPads. iPads are managed to only allow access to educational online services and applications approved by St. James Parish Schools. These devices use internet content filtering. This device will monitor all web activity and daily and monthly data limits are also in place. Use of these devices will also be monitored remotely. Technical support for hotspots will be available once the device is picked up.

If multiple students from the same household require the use of a hotspot, the device will be issued at the school of the oldest student. Parents must pick up the hotspot from the school site.
